## God Speaks To Us Through His Word

*LORD'S DAY 23 - Heidelberg Catechism Questions*

61. Why do you say that you are righteous by faith only?

**A. Not that I am acceptable to God, on account of the worthiness of my faith; but because only by the satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ, is my righteousness before God; and because I cannot receive and apply the same to myself any other way than by faith only.**

*LORD'S DAY 24 - Heidelberg Catechism Questions*

62. But why cannot our good works be the whole or part of our righteousness before God?

**A. Because the righteousness that can be approved of, before the tribunal of God, must be absolutely perfect, and in all respects, conform to the divine law; and also because our best works in this life, are all imperfect and defiled with sin.**

63. What?! Do not our good works merit what God will reward in this and in a future life?

**A. This reward is not of merit, but of grace.**

64. But does not this doctrine make men careless and profane?

**A. By no means: for it is impossible that those, who are implanted into Christ by a true faith, should not bring forth fruits of thankfulness.**
